WP 1

Support NCs, PACs, EC in implementation

- Help in building networks
- Facilitate horizontal activities
- Organise events on general issues or several PA
- Support for AF
- Platform for civil society, regional & multi-level governance

WP 2

Support communication

- Collection of information on projects, targets, other relevant developments
- Communication and publicity tools & materials
- Support PACs communication activities

WP 3

Support monitoring & evaluation

- Providing input for decision – making at ministerial & senior official level
- Support revision of EUSDR documents
- Support evaluation procedures
- Development & management of reporting tool

WP 4

Linking EUSDR to DTP, MRS

- Support exchange of information
- Organise regular communication
- Coordination of communication activities
