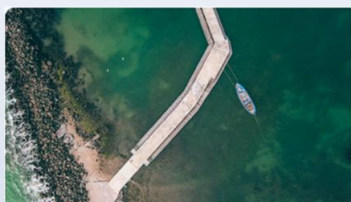
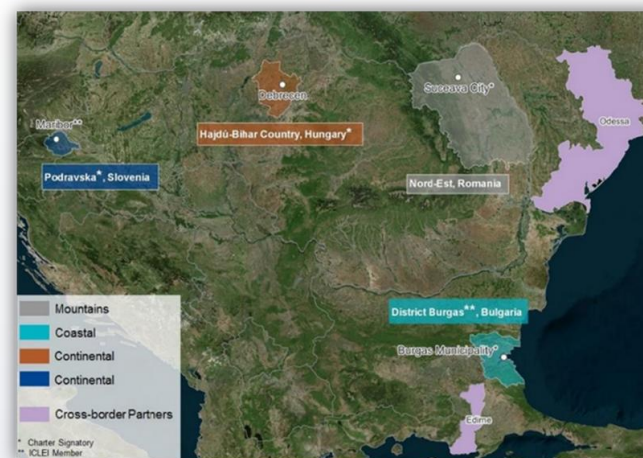
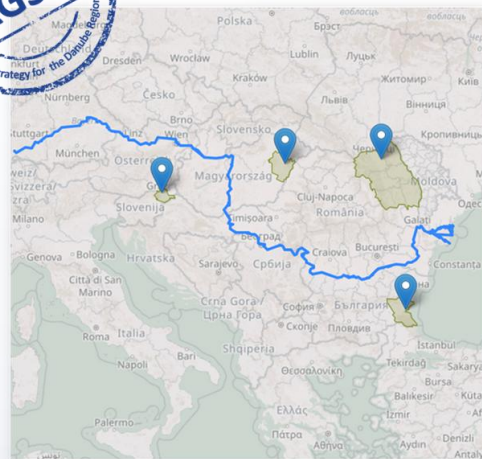
MISSION

VISION

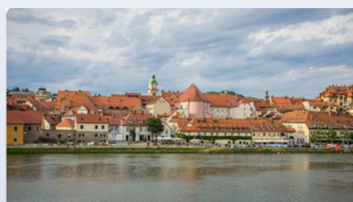

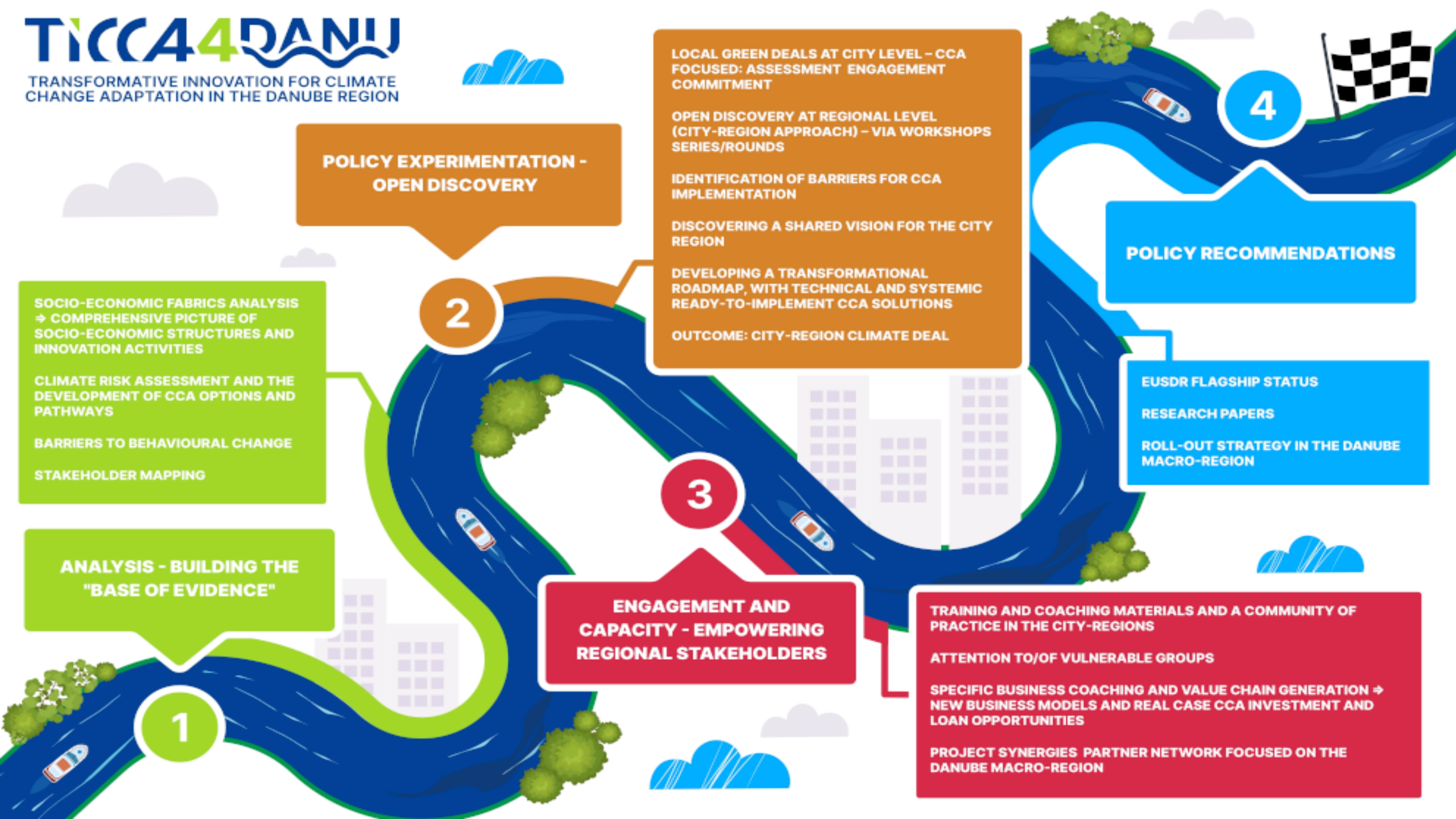

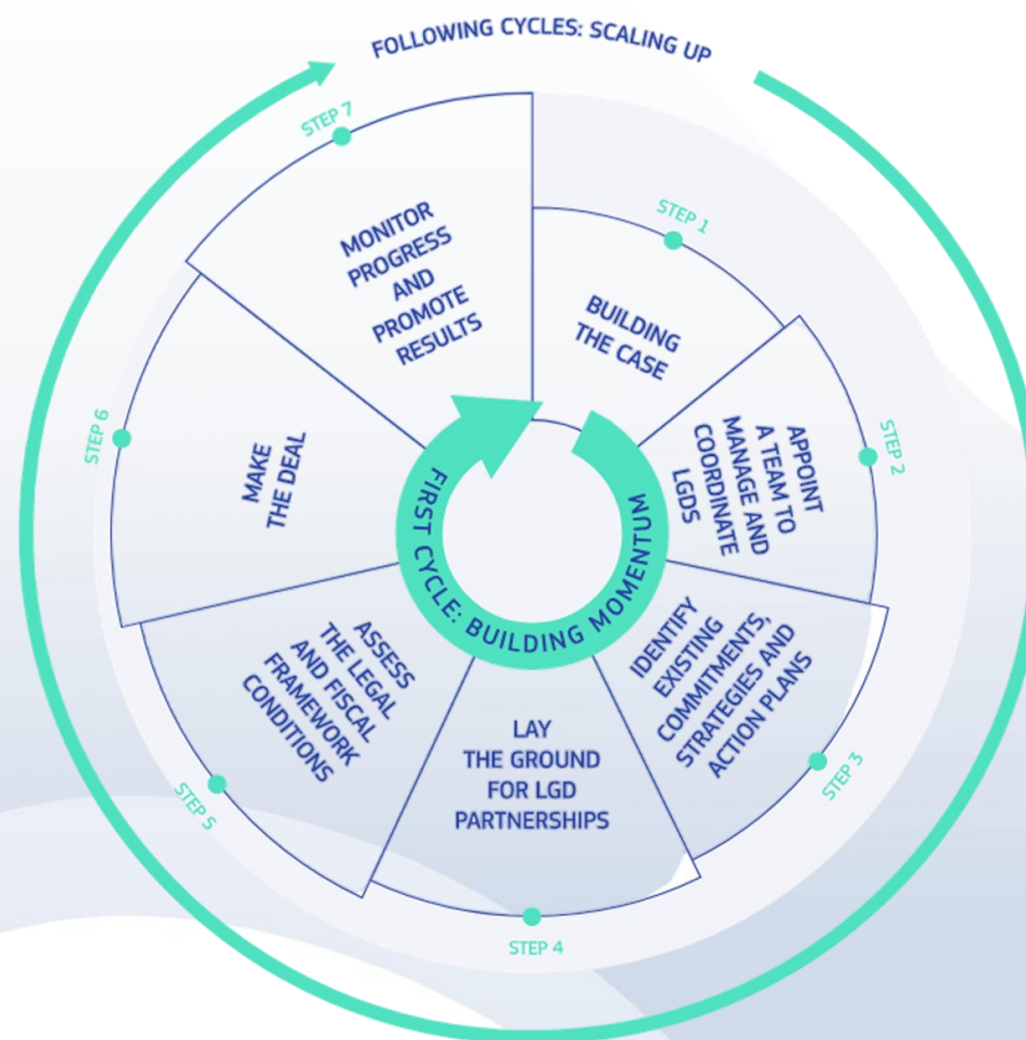
Local Green Deals (LGDs): A Framework for Transformative Action

Core tool in TiCCA4Danu, guiding anchor and fellow cities to design transformative workplans and scalable solutions.



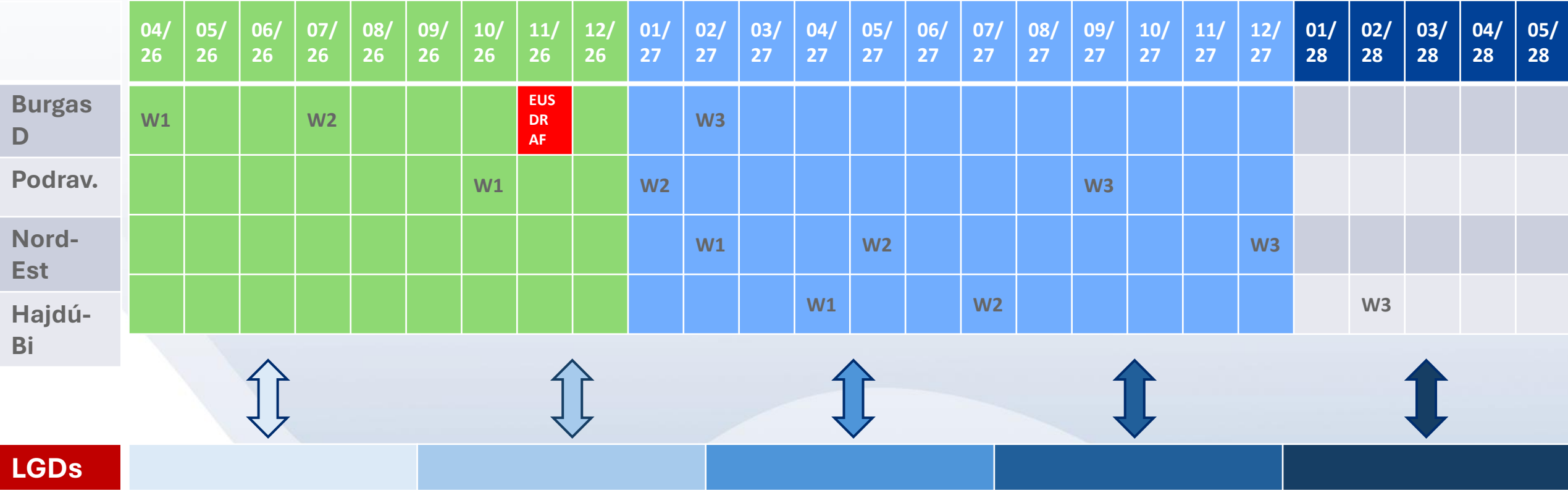
