Participating countries: Austria, Czech Republic, Republic of Serbia and Slovak Republic

55 applications, **19 projects funded**

- **2019: 2nd Call**

Participating countries: AT, CZ, SRB, SK + France

55 applications, **20 projects funded**

Participating countries: AT, CZ, SRB, SK, FR + Bulgaria and Montenegro

Aims of the Call:

- Strengthening cross-border research cooperation
- Contributing to research capacity development in the region
- Providing an opportunity for young/female researchers to cooperate in an international setting and to develop their scientific careers;
- Facilitating joint participation in European research projects

Some key aspects:

- open to all scientific disciplines and thematic areas
- Funding for visits and exchanges of scientists conducting joint research
- Maximum duration: two years for collaborative research projects jointly developed and completed by researchers from a minimum of 3 participating countries.
