



#### **Summary Innovation Index**



The S immary Innovation Index (SII) is a composite indicator calculated using an unweighted average of 32 indicators. It measures the performance of national innovation systems, assessing their relative strengths and weaknesses. This evaluation helps identify areas that require attention and improvement.
