- 1st Call –54 projects under implementation
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Call closed 6 June 2017 (approx. 60 mil euro to planned to be committed)
- PAC Call: 12 projects under implementation
- SMF Call: open till 7 December 2017

3<sup>rd</sup> Call – TBD (potentially to be launched end 2018 - beginning 2019)

### Aim and format of the SMF



to support the <u>development</u> of complex strategic transnational projects contributing to the EU Strategy for the Danube Region



Targeted only to a limited number of topics for each EUSDR Priority Area



### Project structure



#### **<u>Output 1</u>**: Report on the state of play in the addressed field

- Description of the situation in the field and countries
- Description of the target groups addressed by the future project and their needs

#### Output 2: Main project work plan

- A work plan, describing activities, outputs and expected results of the main project
- The composition of the potential project partnership;
- An indicative budget plan for the main project

#### **<u>Output 3</u>**: Report on funding possibilities

- The analysis of funding sources for the main project
- A road map defining steps to be taken after the seed money project is finalised
