PA7 Workshop Information Day on Horizon Europe Opportunities for Danube Countries | Online | 24 May 2023

PA7 with a support of the Slovak Centre of Scientific and Technical Information organized an Infoday on Horizon Europe Twinning Call 2023 bringing together potential applicants from the Danube Region with the Horizon Europe programme authorities and successful project implementors in order to support their participation in the upcoming calls.

Promotion of Danube region researchers and innovators – first online stream organized in cooperation with PA4 | 10 November 2023

PA7 this year prepared its fourth public online stream with a renowned Danube Region Scientist <u>Dr. rer. nat. Peter Malík, PhD.</u> representing Slovak State Geological Institute of Dionyz Stur.

PA7 Steering group meetings in 2023 | 2 June and 27-28 December 2023 | Hybrid

The **25th PA7 Steering group meeting** was organized in a hybrid form on 2 June 2023 in Bratislava with the main aim to present the results of the PA7 activities in relation to the new DRP project for PACs. The leaders of PA7 working groups introduced their ongoing activities and similarly leaders of the approved Danube flagships informed participants about their results and successes. Two new flagship projects were supported by the SG.

On 27 and 28 November, 2023, PA7 in cooperation with the University of Maribor organized the **26th Steering Group meeting in hybrid form in Meranovo, Slovenia**. It was focused on the implementation of PA7 and EUSDR activities, continuation of the revitalized working groups and introduction of the Austrian EUSDR Presidency activities.

The EU Macro-Regional Strategies Week is the biggest annual event dedicated to the four EU macro-regional strategies (<u>EUSBSR</u>, <u>EUSDR</u>, <u>EUSAIR</u>, <u>EUSALP</u>). This year, the event focuses on three main themes: Energy, Skills, and Funding, and is centered around the motto "Transform and Thrive". Dr Csefalvayova as a representative of the PA7 flagship project Danube Tech Valley Initiative led one of the stakeholders' sessions focused on the contribution of the Regional Innovation Valleys to cohesive EU via funding & shared knowledge, where primarily the mitigating measures, best practices and the learning curve in funding innovation, developing RIV and role of MRS were discussed.

The **12th Annual Forum of the EUSDR** was organized in Brdo pri Kranju (Slovenia) and offered a real and actual perspective of the challenges that the Danube Region faces. With the motto **EUSDR Entering the Decade of the Future**, the Forum will feature discussions on the EU enlargement and support to the accession countries, the recovery of Ukraine, the embedding process, energy and transport challenges of the Region, youth involvement in the EUSDR and professions of the future. New Call for Proposals of the DRP open | Seed Money Facility | 27 November 2023 – 29 March 2024

The **EUSDR Seed money facility (SMF)** serves as a tool for kick-starting the development of projects in line with the 12 Priority Areas of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region. Proposals submitted under the 2nd SMF call shall be aligned to at least one EUSDR Priority Area and shall clearly address the EUSDR Action Plan and targets.

There is a possibility to register for the **online lead applicant webinar** in organisation of the MA/JS which will take place on 15 February 2024 (<u>registration</u> will open in January 2024).

Cooperation with Danube Youth Council

Giving a voice to the young generation, members of the <u>Danube Youth</u> <u>Council</u> (DYC) have been involved in a year-long campaign to have their say on the topic they feel passionate about – brain drain and talent development in the Danube Region. To secure the long-term perspective and future work of the DYC, the work programme and financing framework for the DYC was endorsed.

Apart from DYC, the EUSDR incited the process of establishing a so-called **Danube Youth Organisations Network (DYON)** open to national or regional youth organisations or other entities working on youth issues established in the Danube Region to offer a **platform** to cooperate and share their needs and experiences, both among themselves and to the EUSDR governance.
